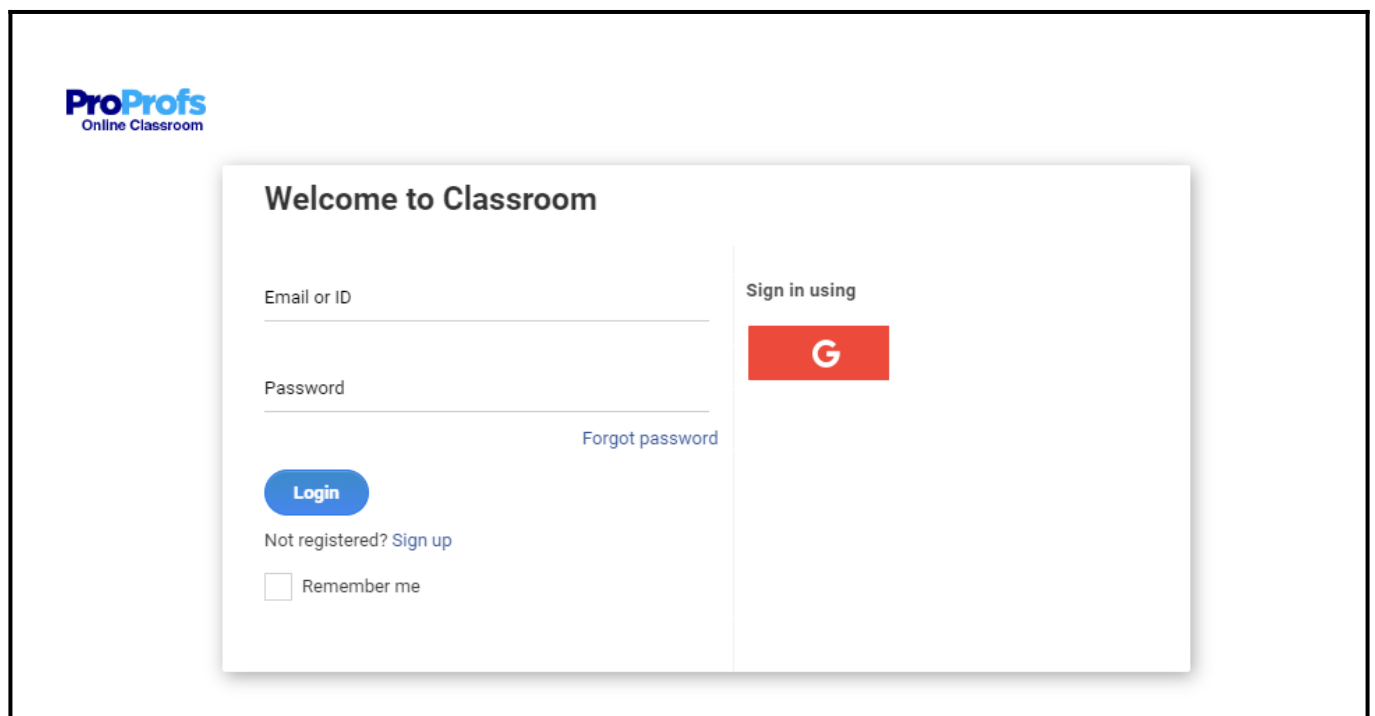


How to Enable Google Single Sign-on Login for a Classroom

Here's a look at a classroom login page featuring Single Sign-On (SSO):

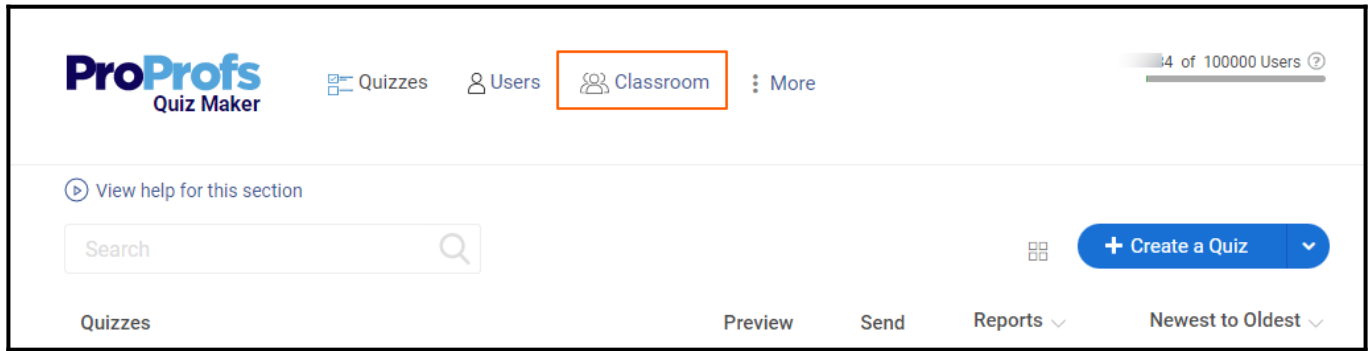


Benefits of Single sign-on using Google login:

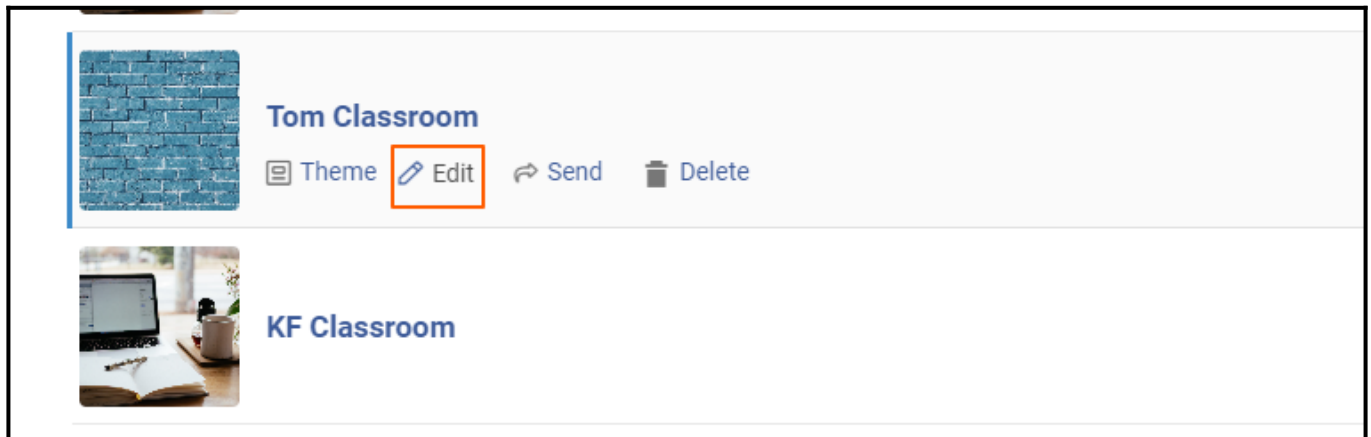
- You only have to log in once. After that, you'll be redirected automatically when logging in again.

How to Enable Single Sign-on for a Classroom

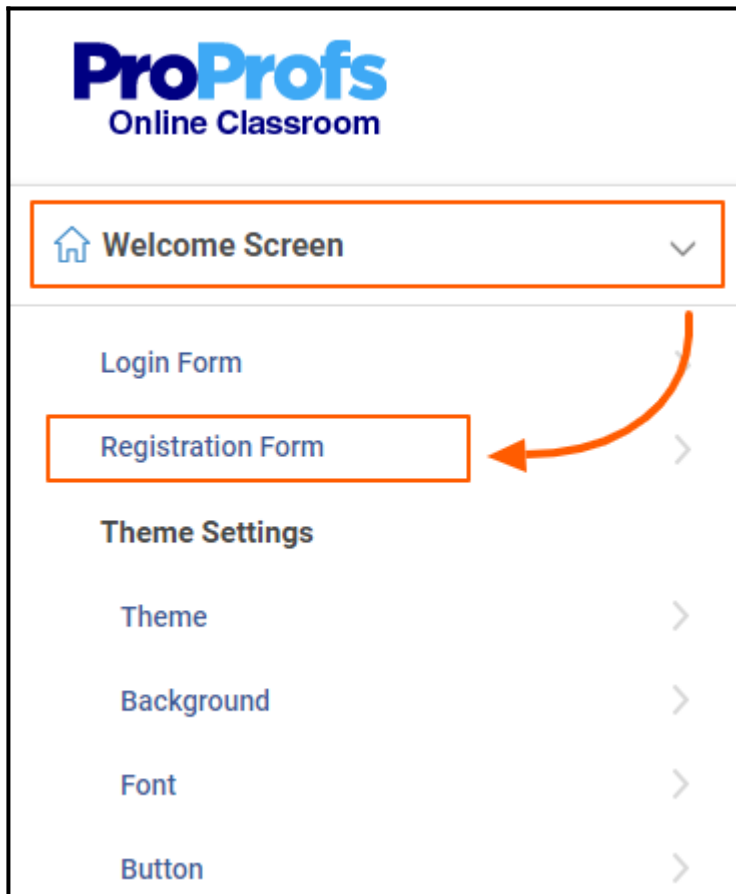
Step 1: Log in to your ProProfs Quiz Maker account and go to **Classroom**.



Step 2: Navigate to your classroom and click **"Edit."**
