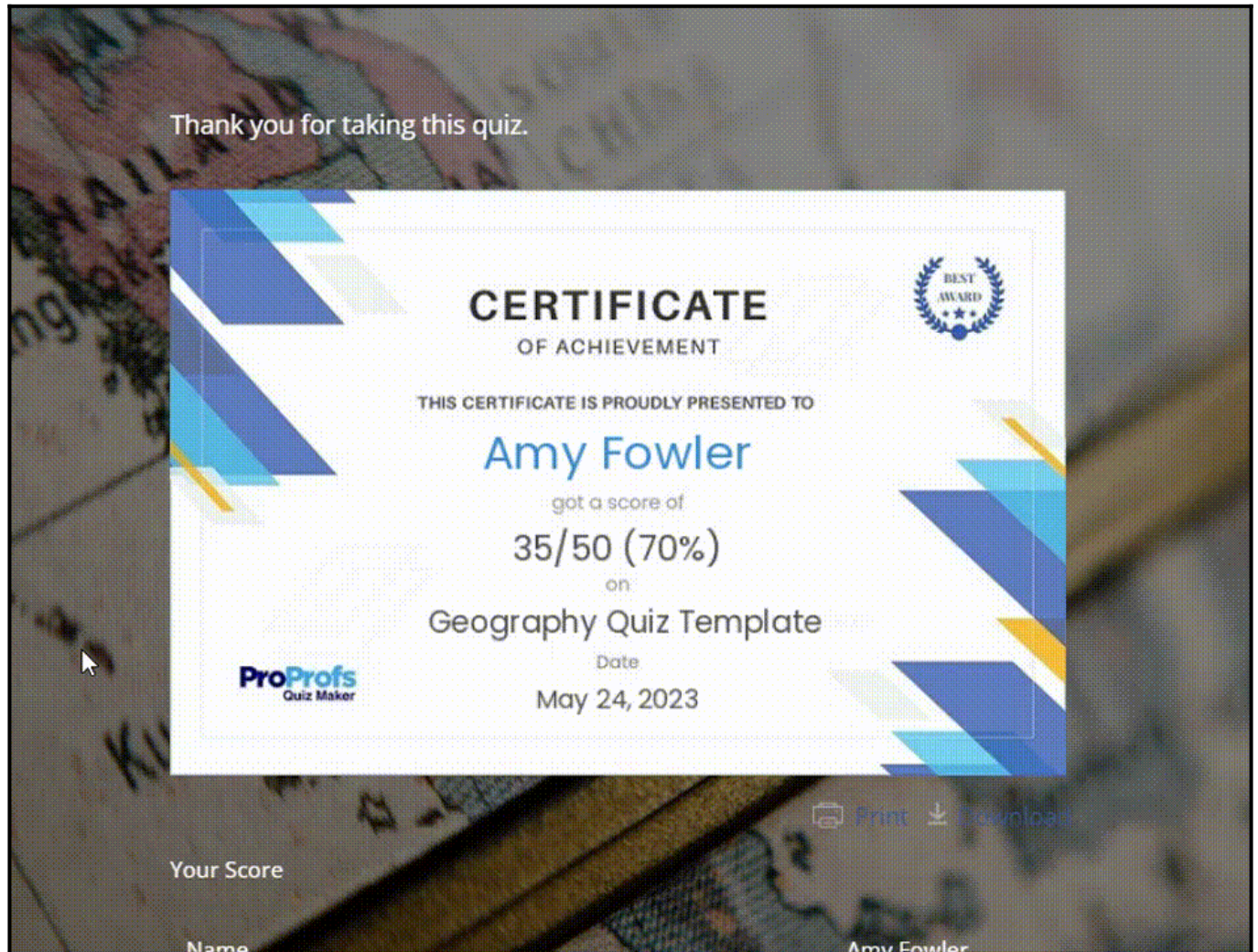


How to Show Quiz Scores Based on Tags in Learner Reports

With ProProfs Quiz Maker, learners can view their results organized by topic. This allows them to quickly identify areas where they excel and where they may need to focus more effort.

Here's what the quiz report with topic-based results looks like.



Benefits of showing scores based on tags:

- Tag-based scoring provides a breakdown of scores to help learners identify their strong and weak areas.
- It also helps learners track their progress in a specific topic.

To show scores based on topics in learners' reports:

Step 1: You must **tag the questions** according to topics to show results based on them. Go to **Settings > General > Scoring > Choose "Assign points to each question" > Manage Point Assignment**.



Step 2: Navigate to **Order**. Select **"Shuffle Questions"** for "Order of Questions" and choose **"Select by tags"** for "Number of Questions," then set up the number of questions according to the tags you have used.
