

How to Create a Matching Quiz

A **Matching** quiz can be created using the **Matching** question-type. It has options arranged in two columns and the quiz takers are required to match the options in the second column with the correct options in the first column.


For example, this is how a Matching question looks like:

Match the capitals with their countries

New Zealand	Select a Match ▼
India	Select a Match ▼
Italy	Select a Match ▼

Here's how to create Matching quizzes:

Step 1: The Matching question type is available for the **Scored quiz** only, so begin by creating a Scored quiz. Once in the editor, click **Matching** under the **Questions** option.

1. Enter the question.

2. Enter **choices**, **matches**, and add more if required.

3. **Advanced:**

- Add **feedback** which is shown after the question is attempted.
- Add **tags** to categorize questions.
- Make the question mandatory for the users to attempt.
- Enable **grading** if you'd like this particular question to impact the overall quiz score.

4. Add an **image** if you want. Once you're done, **save**. Your Matching question is ready.
