

To Create a Scored Quiz Online

Step 1: Access Your ProProfs Quiz Maker Account

- Log in to your ProProfs Quiz Maker account.
- On the dashboard, click the "+ Create a Quiz" button. This will take you to a new page where you can start building your guiz.




Step 2: Select a Quiz Template or Start from Scratch

- For this tutorial, click "+ Create Your Own" to open the quiz builder and start from scratch.




• Click "+ Create Your Own." to open the quiz builder.




Step 3: Here's how the quiz builder looks to the editor. We will start with basic editing.



• Customize your quiz by adding a title, image, and description. Click Edit Cover




• Follow the screenshot instructions to customize your quiz.




- 1. **Quiz Title:** Give your quiz a title to help quiz takers know what it is all about. Also, the title enables you to distinguish quizzes on your dashboard.
- 2. Add Media: Upload an image/video or choose from the ProProfs library. You can also search

for an image on Google or Pexels or a video on YouTube, integrated with our quiz builder. Select an image/video and click **Done.**




- 3. **Description:** Add details about your quiz to give quiz takers some extra information.
- Click **Save** at the end to confirm your changes and proceed further.




Step 4: Add Questions to Your Quiz

• Click + New Question.



• Choose a question type based on your requirements. Let's add a multiple-choice question by selecting **Multiple Choice** from the palette and clicking **Add**.




Note: ProProfs Quiz Maker showcases an example of the chosen question type to ease your decision-making.

Note: The Import Questions feature lets you bulk add questions from an already created quiz or an excel sheet in a prescribed format.

- A multiple-choice question shows up on the Quiz Editor main page. Every element of the question is editable.
- You can write a question and add the options.



Additional Customization Options for Questions:




- 1. You can add your feedback to a question.
- 2. You can add a tag to a question to categorize your questions
- 3. You can add branching to guide quiz takers to different questions based on their answers, creating a more personalized experience.
- 4. You can Make certain questions mandatory for quiz takers to proceed.
- 5. You can enable grading to make it a scoring question.
- 6. You can seek quiz takers' comments to understand why they chose an option before proceeding to the next question.

Note: ProProfs Quiz Maker lets you design your quiz the way you like. Play around with every element to make your quiz more engaging.


Step 6: Preview Your Quiz

Here's how the quiz will look to learners.




Step 7: Customize Results, Settings, and Themes




In the left panel of the quiz editor, you can configure several aspects of your quiz:


1. **Results:** Choose the type of result you want to provide to the quiz takers once they complete the quiz. You can pick one from the dropdown or customize your result the way you want.




2. **Popular Settings:** You can use popular settings to customize scoring when creating a scored quiz. Also, you can modify question order and visibility. To go to the settings page, click **All Settings**.



3. **Popular Themes:** Select a theme for your quiz from preloaded options or Customize the theme to match your branding.




Step 8: After creating your quiz, you can access your dashboard by clicking on the header logo.
