

# How to Enable Random Question Selection From a Question Bank

With ProProfs, you can pool questions randomly from a [question bank](#). By doing so, each of your quiz takers gets the questions in a different order. They may also get a completely different set of questions for the same quiz.

For example, there are 20 questions in your question bank, and out of them, you have assigned ten random questions to your quiz takers. Now, each of your quiz takers may get ten different questions from the same question bank or the same ten questions in a different order.

Benefits of random question selection using a question bank:

- Prevent or minimize cheating among learners
- Easily reduce the effort in invigilating tests

To enable random question selection from a question bank:

**Step 1.** Go to quiz **Settings >> General** and scroll down to the **Order** section. Click on the **Order of Questions** dropdown and select **Shuffle questions**. You can also choose to click **Shuffle answers** or **Shuffle questions & answers** depending on your preference.
