
# **How to View the Grade Book Report**

#### Here's what a grade book report looks like:




#### A few benefits of a grade book report:

- Improved organization: Every critical data related to a learner's performance in quizzes will be at a centralized location


## To view the grade book report:

**Step 1:** Go to **Classroom > Groups** of a classroom in your Quiz Maker account.





**Step 2:** Select a group and navigate to the **Reports** option.




**Step 3:** Choose **Grade Book** from the dropdown menu.



**Step 4:** The Grade Book report provides the following info:

- 1. A list of the learners added to the group
- 2. Average points scored
- 3. Total points
- 4. Points per Quiz
- 5. Download the report or share the report link with your peers.



**Note:** The personality quizzes differ from scored quizzes. Hence, their points are not displayed in the grade book.
