

How to Shuffle or Randomize Quiz Questions & Answers

You can shuffle or randomize quiz questions and answers so that no two learners get questions and answer options in the same order while taking a quiz. This security setting helps you prevent cheating among your learners.

To shuffle or randomize quiz questions and answers, follow the steps below:

Step 1. Go to quiz **Settings >> General** and find the **Order** section. From the 'Order of Questions' dropdown, choose whether you want to **shuffle questions, answers, or both**. Click **Save** to save your settings.
