## How to Assign Individual Username/Password to Quiz Takers



Learners will need to log in to the classroom, with the username and password you've created, to access the quizzes.


Preview of the classroom login screen:



How to Create or Change Username/Password of a User


**Step 1:** In your Quiz Maker account,

- Navigate to "**Settings**" >> "**Security.**"
- Select "Private access for selected users & groups."
- Click "Manage Users" to set up the usernames and passwords for users & groups.




You will be redirected to your classroom, where you can add new learners and create usernames and passwords for them, or you can change the usernames and passwords for the existing users.

**Step 2:** To change the username or password of a user, click on the first name or last name.
