

How to Set Password and Accessibility to a Quiz

You can create password protected quizzes, where learners will be required to enter the password before they take the quiz. We also offer a number of other options by which you can [make your quizzes private and secure](#).

Step 1: On your quiz setting page, under "Security and Tracking", create a password for the quiz and click on "Save".
