

# How to Ensure Quizzes Created With ProProfs Work on Safari

Superior HTML5 technology powers quizzes created at ProProfs. This technology ensures that your quizzes on ProProfs load faster and run on all kinds of mobile devices such as iPhone, iPad, Android. Also on browsers including Internet Explorer, Firefox, Safari, Google Chrome and more.

However, at times Safari's default cookie settings block third-party apps. As a result, learners trying to access [quizzes embedded on your website](#) or blog using Safari might not be able to do so. In case you are accessing your quiz directly at ProProfs.com, the same will work fine across all platforms and mobile devices.

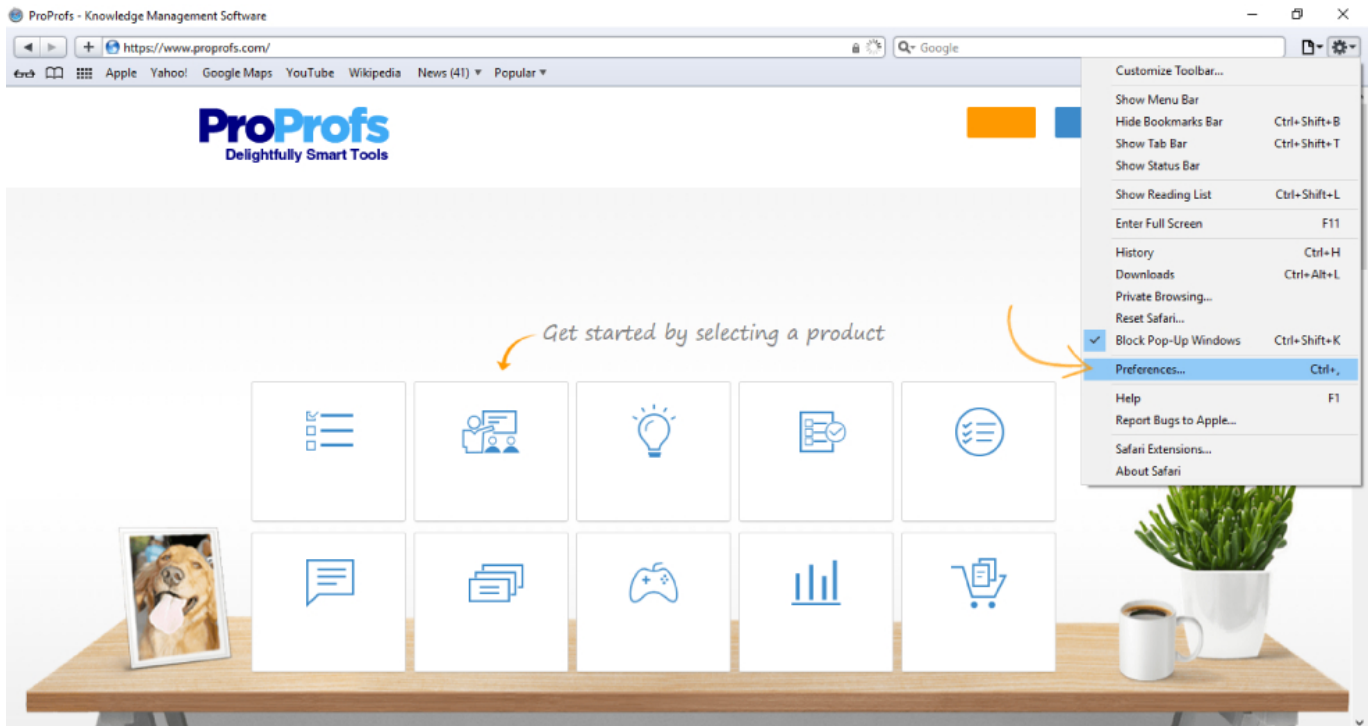
**\*Note:** This article describes a rare scenario that usually does not happen unless the settings in the browser are non-default.

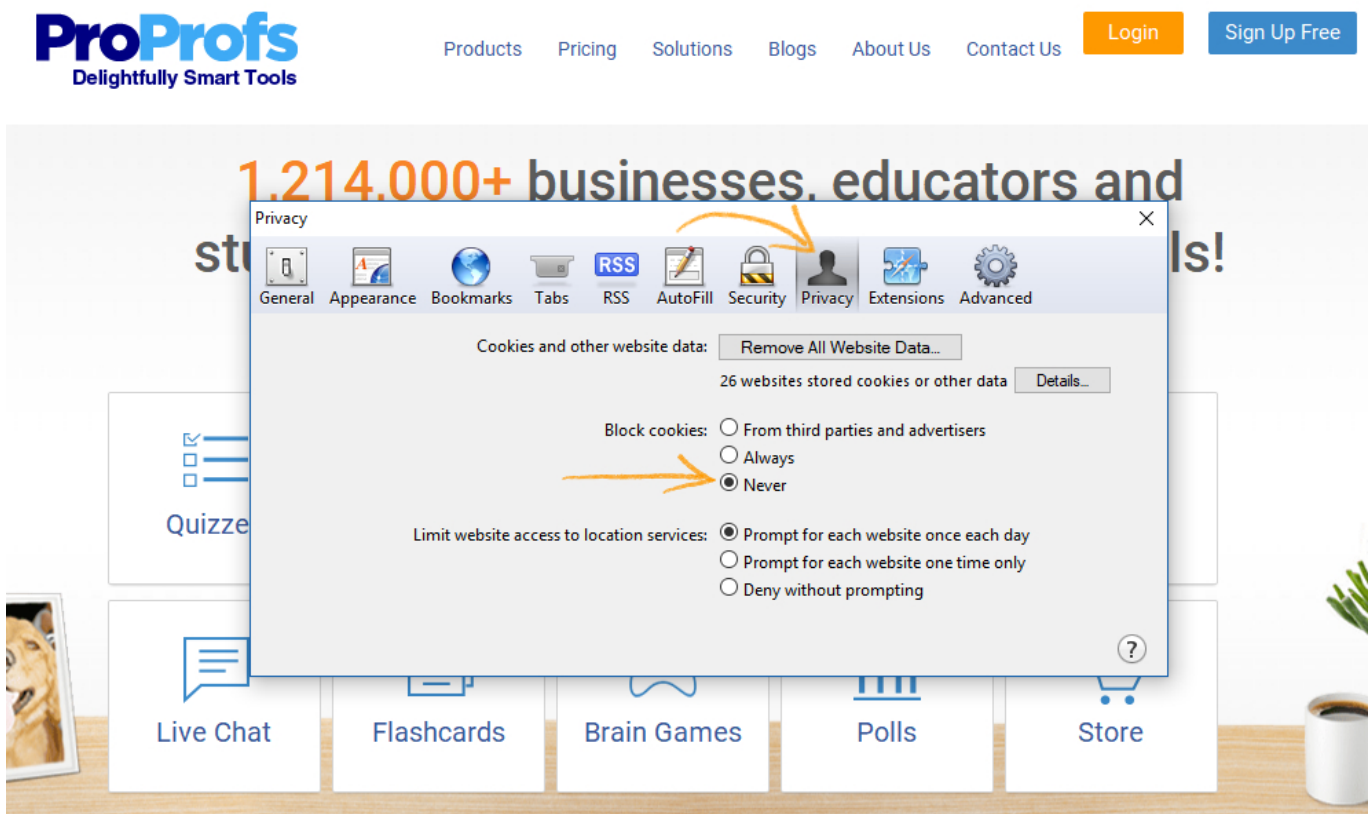

## Safari on Windows

**Step 1.** Open Safari and go to the quiz that is not working. Go to Safari settings and click on **Preferences**.

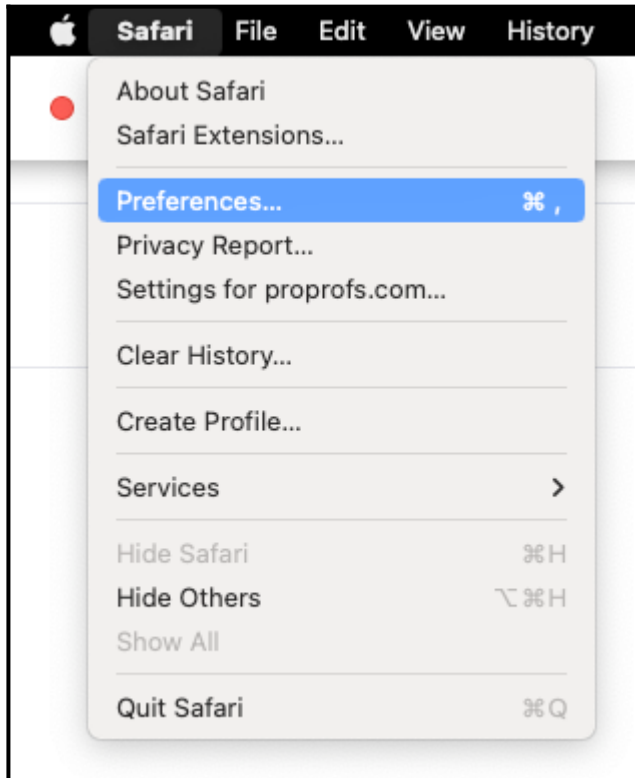


**Step 2.** Under **Privacy** tag >> **Block cookies**, you can see three options: "From third party and advertisers," "Always" and "Never." Make sure Block cookies is set to "**Never**."

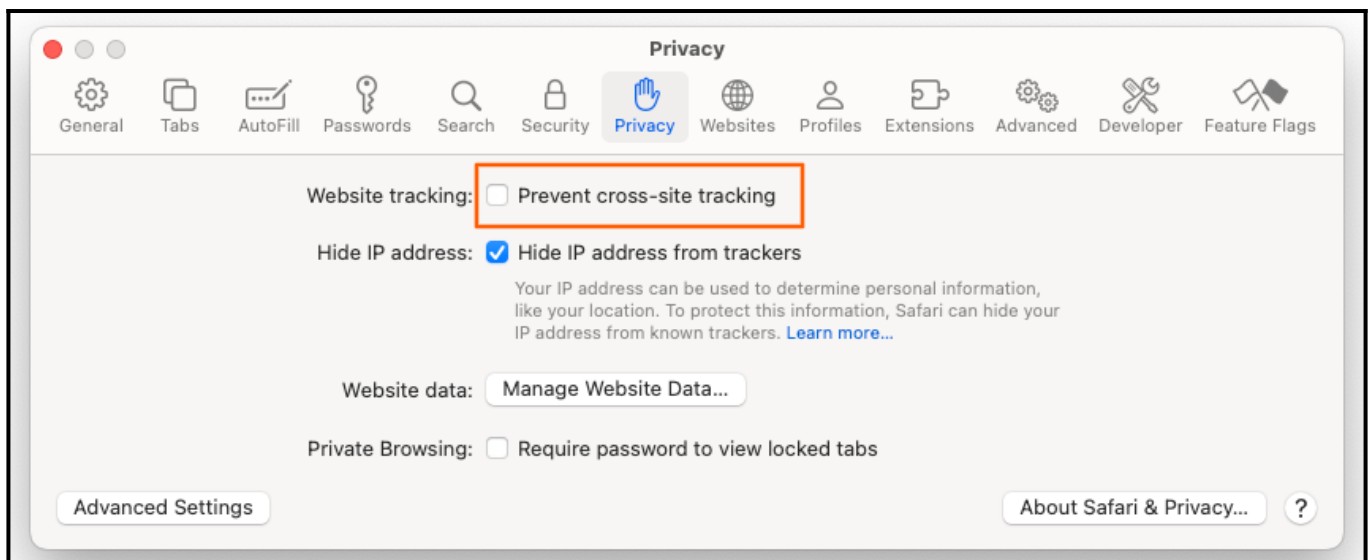


## Safari on Mac

**Step 1:** Open Safari and go to the quiz that is not working. Click **Safari > Preferences**.

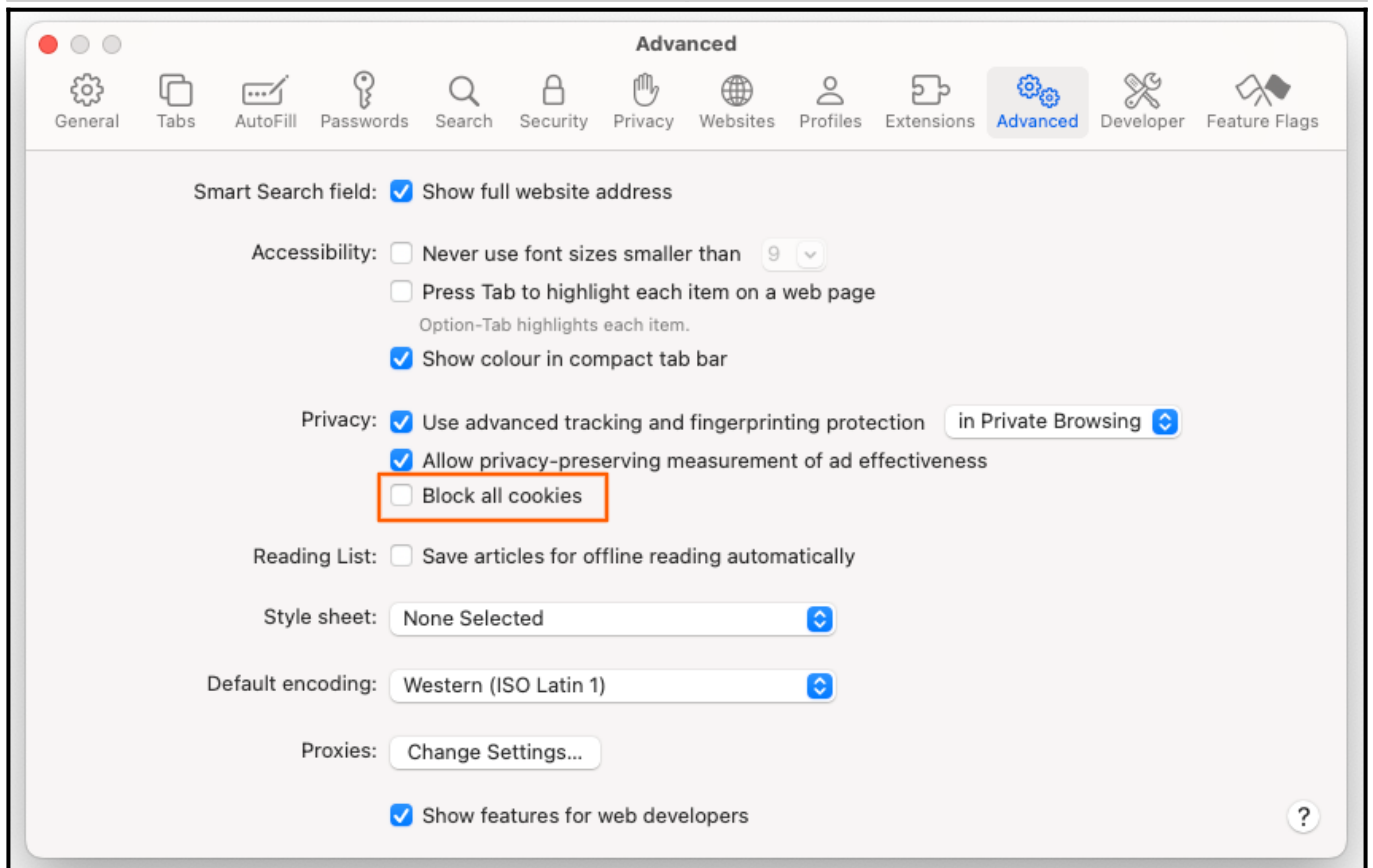


**Step 2:** Go to the **Privacy** tab. Untick the checkbox for "**Prevent cross-site tracking**".



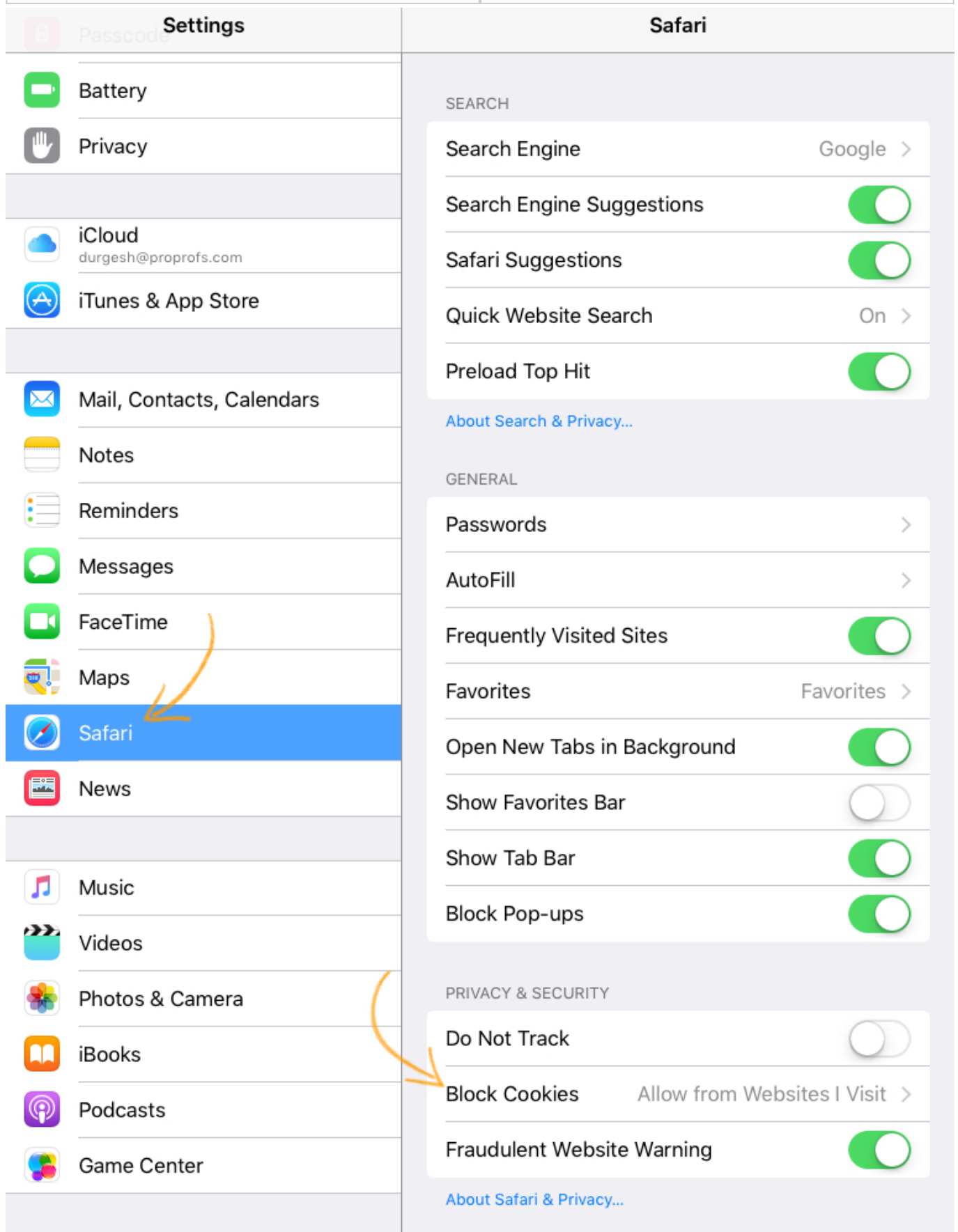
**Step 3:** Click on **Advanced Settings** (located in the bottom-left corner of the Privacy tab) or go to the **Advanced** tab directly.

- Ensure the option "**Block all cookies**" is disabled.




## Safari on iPad


**Step 1.** Open iPad settings and select **Safari**.





**Step 2.** In **Privacy >> Block Cookies**, you can see four options: "Always Block," "Allow from Current Website Only," "Allow from websites I Visit," and "Always Allow." Make sure Block Cookies is set to "**Always Allow.**"

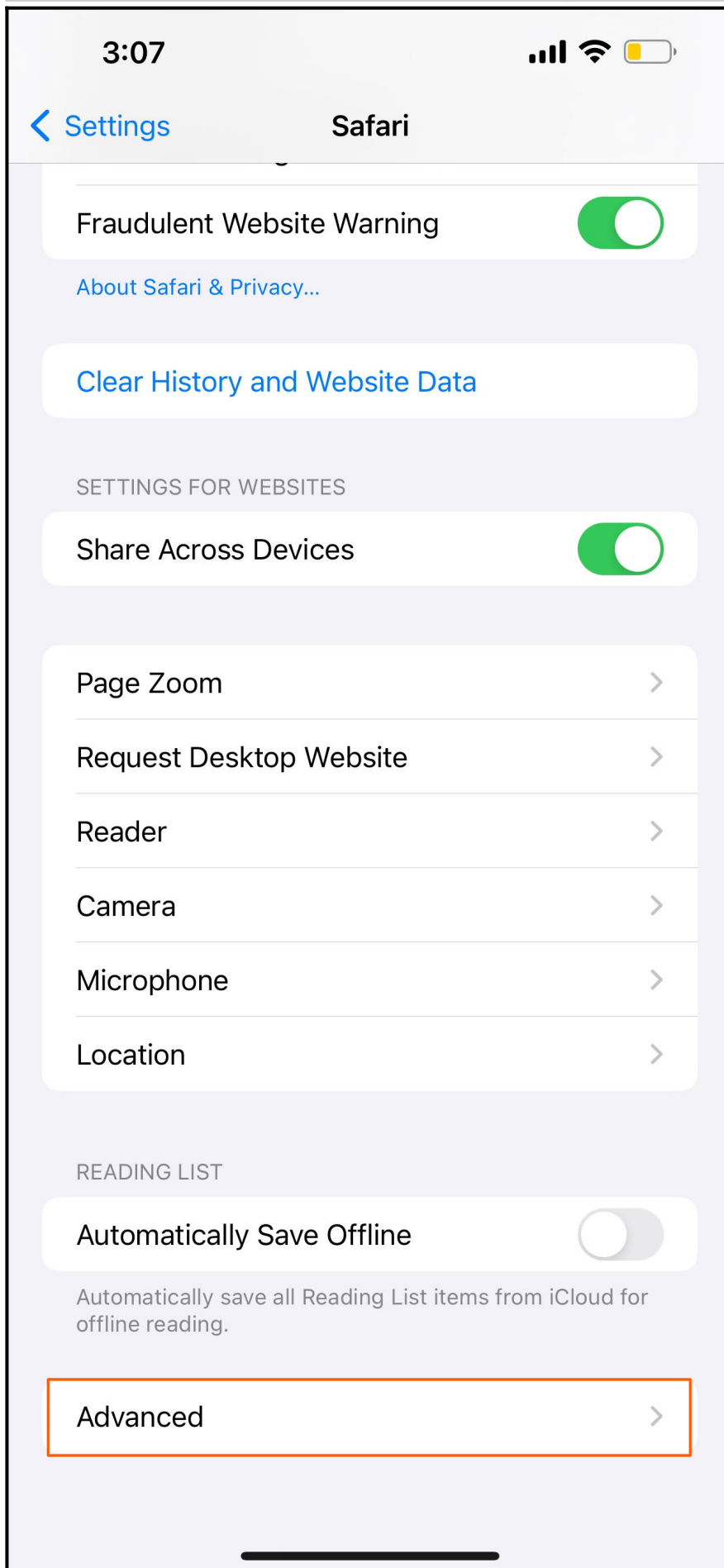

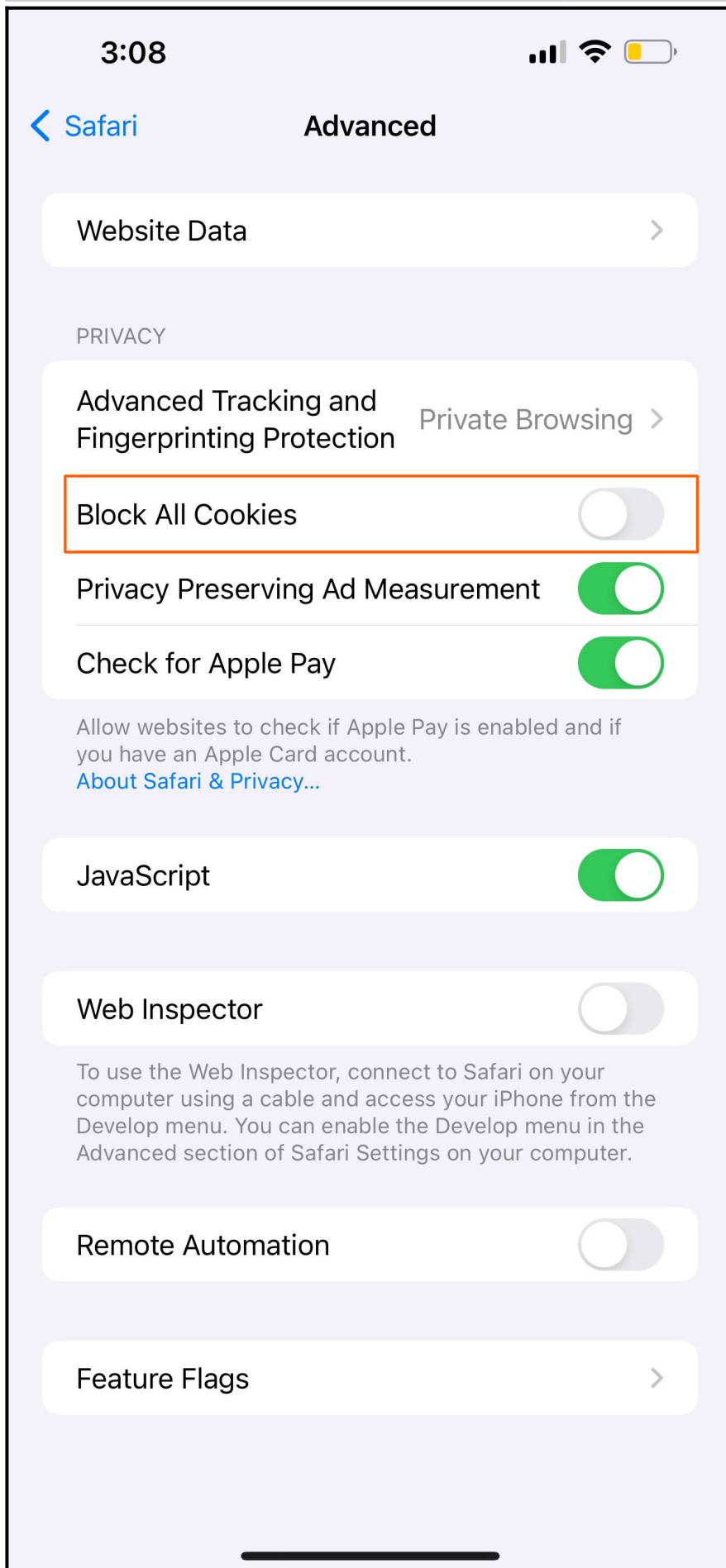
