

How to Create a Cloze Test

A cloze test is perfect for testing your learners' understanding of context and vocabulary. It is a quiz with two question types - [fill in the blanks](#) and [multiple choices](#).

Here's a preview of how a cloze test will appear:

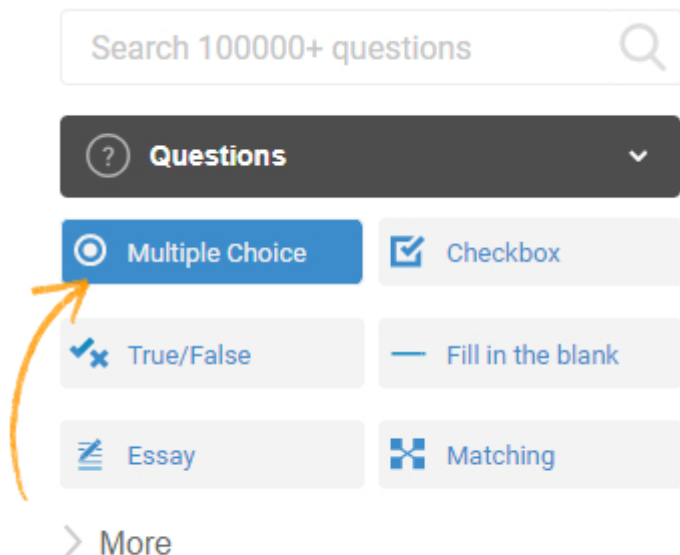

To demonstrate the process, let's create a cloze test for the proverb "All work and no play makes Jack a dull boy."

Step 1: [Create a new quiz](#) and select multiple choice question type to start.



Step 2: Add content to the question box omitting the preferred words, use underscore to include blanks in place of the words. Here, we use the proverb as "All ___ and no ___ makes Jack a ___ boy." Add the answer choices - *work (correct answer)*, *play (incorrect answer)*. Click "Save" to add the question.
